## Sleemans, Canada

Canada's unsung beer brand arises from five generations of colourful brewing personalities and a unique recipe book that dates back to the 19th century.

John Sleeman spent his early adulthood somewhat oblivious to his family's brewing history; their family brewing history was rarely discussed. After getting married in England, he and his wife returned to Canada to open their own English pub stocked with authentic English beers. After a few years in the business, John was paid a visit by his Aunt Florian, who came armed with an historic Sleeman bottle and the words, 'It's time you found out about your heritage.'

John's family's brewing tradition in Canada extends back to 1834 when John H. Sleeman arrived in Ontario from Cornwall, England. By 1851, he started the first Sleeman brewery to be located in Guelph, Ontario, brewing small 100-barrel batches. An empire was now on its way to being reborn & Sleemans is now firmly established as one of Canada's finest breweries.



### Honey Brown Lager
